

Below is a list of fatalities caused by falls through skylights in the past 15 months. Names of victims and companies withheld.

Date	Location	Incident
7/23/2009	Webster, TX	Victim was performing roofing operations. While removing a skylight on the roof, stepped into the open hole and fell.
8/25/2009	Whitehouse Station, NJ	Worker fell through a skylight.
9/4/2009	Doraville, GA	Employee was working on a roof top performing some voltage testing on an exhaust fan. He fell 25.8 feet through the roof skylight, landing on the concrete inside the building.
9/21/2009	San Antonio, TX	Worker was carrying tools to the other side of a metal corrugated roof and fell 25-feet through one of the skylights.
9/28/2009	Broadview, IL	Worker was performing roofing work on a low slope roof and fell through an unprotected skylight.
11/4/2009	Oxford, NC	The worker was repairing a skylight on the roof. He fell through the skylight area to the concrete pad. The worker died on the scene.
12/20/2009	Newbery Park, PA	Worker, who is the owner, was doing electrical work and fell through the skylight.
4/7/2010	Plano, TX	Worker was installing a roof and fell 20 feet through a skylight, landing on the ground.
4/14/2010	Norcross, GA	Worker was repairing a roof and fell through the skylight, 20 feet to the concrete floor.
9/16/2010	Pensacola, FL	Worker was replacing a metal roof and fell through a skylight.
10/7/2010	Elk Grove Village, IL	Worker was replacing a metal roof and fell through a skylight.
